1 Procedure for applications for International competitions

- 1. The skater shall have reached the minimums at a valid competition before application deadline.
- 2. Application must be submitted three (3) weeks before the entry deadline for each competition. Att. International competitions held in Iceland are included.
- 3. Attached with an application should be protocols that show the minimums. Guardians/Coach are responsible to send in all relevant information to <u>info@iceskate.is</u>
- 4. Processing time is two (2) weeks and is handled by the ÍSS office.

ATT. Prococols are not automatically reviewed. It is the applicants responsibility to show that the skater has reached the minimums at each given time.

2 Conditions for application

A skater who applies to participate in an international competition shall have reached the age of 12 before the start of the season (July 1st).

All competitors in Basic Novice, who wish to compete at an international event, must submit að protocol.

A skater can apply for a maximum of two (2) competitions per season.

Skaters must demonstrate actice competition participation durin the season. Active participation is a minimum of one competition each semseter.

No more than five (5) months can have passed since the last competition when applying.

A skater is considered as an active competitor in a category when they have competed in a valid competition in said category. Competitions are valid according to regulation 302.

2.1 Program Elements

The program elements are considered according to the competition rules. The minimum requriements for the category must be met along with the following requirements:

Basic Novice

- 1A
- Min 3 different double jumps
- CoSp/CcoSp Level 2
- Step Sequence (StSq) Level 1

2.1.1 The following applies to the evaluation of program elements

- Jumps with GOE -5 or << are not considered a fulfilled element unless otherwise specifically stated.
- Spins with GOE -3 are not considered a fulfilled element
- StSq with GOE -3 are not considered a fulfilled element
